The University of Tampa is committed to providing accurate information to all students to aid in career planning. The UT Program in Nursing prepares students to practice in a field with professional licensure or certification available. However, specific licensure and certification requirements can vary by state.

The MSN and PMC programs are accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). By virtue of CCNE accreditation, the MSN nursing program offers a curriculum necessary for eligibility to sit for the ANNP and/or AANPCB national certification exams in all 50 states.

MSN graduates must successfully complete a national certification examination to be eligible for advanced practice licensure in the State of Florida. It is the individual graduate's responsibility to apply for the national certification exam, if required by a state's advance practice licensure regulations and meet all requirements for the state in which they choose to practice as an APRN.
