The University of Tampa is committed to providing accurate information to all students to aid in career planning. The UT Program in Physician Assistant Medicine prepares students to practice in a field with professional licensure or certification available. However, specific licensure and certification requirements can vary by state.

All 50 states require graduation from an ARC-PA accredited program and certification following successful completion of the PANCE as conditions for initial PA licensure. By virtue of its ARC accreditation, The University of Tampa's PA program offers a curriculum necessary for licensure in all 50 states. It is the individual graduate's responsibility to apply, complete and pass the PANCE licensure exam after graduation. It is the individual graduate's responsibility to apply for state licensure and meet all requirements for the state in which they choose to practice as a licensed physician assistant."
